Dear Municipal Official:

The Union County Improvement Authority (UCIA), is pleased to announce a Countywide Renewable Energy Program. This program will be offered to all municipalities, public school districts, and local authorities within Union County and will consist of having renewable energy sources such as solar panels or wind devices (hydro-power also may be an option) installed on buildings or grounds identified by each respective participating entity with the goal of accomplishing the following:

- Permitting your municipality, school district or local authority to partner with the UCIA as a program participant and Go Green;
- Reducing a portion of your local entity's dependence on retail electricity, while not requiring your entity to incur any out-of-pocket costs; and
- Structuring the financing through the UCIA in a manner that will have all debt issued through the UCIA, and result in no debt service payments applicable to local entities.
